



PRIVACY POLICY

1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 This Privacy Policy explains how both the Wholesale Market Brokers' Association and WMBA Limited ("**WMBA**", "**we**", "**us**" or "**our**"), a trade association whose registered offices are at St Mary's House, Netherhampton, Salisbury, Wiltshire SP2 8PU, and a company set up by that association at the same address and with company number 06618351 collect information from you when you visit or register to use www.wmba.org.uk (the "**Website**") and how this information is then used. If you have any questions about this statement or your personal information that we may collect from you, please contact us using the "Contacting Us" section below.
- 1.2 Please read this Privacy Policy carefully and re-visit this page from time to time to review any changes that may have been made.

2 DATA PROTECTION ACT 1998

- 2.1 At all times we are legally obliged to collect, retain and process any personal information that you provide in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.
- 2.2 We are registered as a data controller in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998; WMBA Limited is a registered data controller with registration number Z1383991, the Wholesale Market Brokers' Association is a registered data controller with registration number Z119300X. We will process any personal information we collect about you in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.
- 2.3 This Privacy Policy applies to you whether you use the Website as a casual browser, or have registered to use the Website or have entered into a contract with WMBA in relation to the supply of specific services and/or products. In the event of any conflict between this Privacy Policy and the terms of a contract you have with WMBA, the relevant provision of that contract shall prevail to the extent of any inconsistency.

3 PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTED AND HOW IT IS USED

3.1 Information collected when you browse the Website

- 3.2 We may collect and process the following data about you:
- 3.2.1 Information you provide by filling in forms on the Website. We may also ask you for information when you report a problem with our site.
- 3.2.2 If you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence.
- 3.2.3 We may also ask you to complete surveys that we use for research purposes, although you do not have to respond to them.
- 3.2.4 Details of your visits to our site including but not limited to, traffic data, location data, web logs and other communication data.

3.3 Information collected when you register to access the [SONIA™](#) and/or [EURONIA™](#) indices

- 3.3.1 We will collect your name, company name, telephone number, email address and password. We need this information in order to provide

you with access to the indices and to ensure we can identify you for the purposes of licensing. We will use this information only for the purposes of record keeping and providing you with access to related information and services.

3.4 Uses of personal information that we collect

3.4.1 Where we collect personal information, we will use it for administration and to tailor our service and/or products to match your needs. We may also use personal information to conduct market research surveys, for statistical analysis to determine site usage, to run competitions and for direct marketing purposes relating to our business.

3.4.2 We may employ the services of a third party to help us in certain areas, such as website hosting, marketing and market researching. In some cases that third party may receive your information. However, at all times we will control and be responsible for the use of your information.

3.4.3 The data that we collect from you will not be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside the European Economic Area ("EEA").

3.5 Disclosure of personal information

3.5.1 We may disclose your personal information to third parties if we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our Terms of use above and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property or safety of WMBA, our Members, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

3.6 Your Rights

3.6.1 You have the right to ask us not to process your personal data for marketing purposes. We will usually inform you (before collecting your data) if we intend to use your data for such purposes or if we intend to disclose your information to any third party for such purposes. You can exercise your right to prevent such processing by checking certain boxes on the forms we use to collect your data. You can also exercise the right at any time by contacting us using the "Contacting Us" section below.

3.6.2 The Data Protection Act 1998 gives you the right to access information held about you. Any access request may be subject to a fee of £10 to meet our costs in providing you with details of the information we hold about you.

Should you wish WMBA to cease marketing to you, or to update, correct or delete your personal information as appropriate you should contact us using the "Contacting Us" section below.

4 STORAGE OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

4.1 We will hold your personal information securely and will only keep it for as long as is reasonably necessary. We take the security of the Website and the information you provide very seriously and we will take appropriate technical measures using recognized security procedures and tools in accordance with good industry practice to protect your personal information.

4.2 Whilst we use all reasonable endeavours to protect your security in the manner described above, we consider that it is only appropriate to

advise users that data transmission over the Internet and the World Wide Web cannot always be guaranteed as 100% secure, and therefore that you use the Website at your own risk.

5 IP ADDRESSES AND COOKIES

- 5.1 Your Internet browser has a feature called "cookies" which store small amounts of data on your computer about your visit to the Website. A cookie does not provide us with any personal information. Therefore, if you have not supplied us with any personal information, you can still browse our site anonymously.
- 5.2 We do not automatically capture or store personal data from browsers to the site, other than to log your IP address and session information such as the duration of the visit to our site and the nature of the browser used. This information is used only for administration of the site system and in the compilation of statistics used by WMBA.
- 5.3 Cookies may be required to allow you to access and participate in certain areas of the Website. Once you have closed your browser, this type of cookie is deactivated.
- 5.4 The majority of browsers will allow you to alter the settings used for cookies and to disable and enable them as you require. If you do not want cookies then please refer to the help menu on your browser for instructions on disabling them.

- 6.1 If we make any changes to this Privacy Policy these changes will be detailed on this page in order to ensure that you are fully aware of what information is collected, how it is used and under what circumstances it will be disclosed.
